

On June 7th Congressman John B. Larson will hold a Town Hall Meeting at the Konover Campus Center at the University of Hartford. During the forum participants will be encouraged to help balance a mock federal budget by deciding which programs need to be cut, which should be preserved and how they should be paid for.

Congressman Larson believes that the federal budget needs to be balanced fairly. He believes that reasonable spending cuts are necessary and that the budget cannot be balanced on the backs of working families. Larson has also advocated ending taxpayer funded subsidies for oil companies and corporations that ship American jobs overseas and ending tax breaks for the wealthiest Americans.

Recently Republicans in Congress have announced plans to end Medicare as a way to reduce the deficit.
