

**A BILL**

To amend title XI of the Social Security Act to clarify the mailing requirement relating to social security account statements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Know Your Social Se-  
5 curity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF REQUIREMENT TO MAIL SOCIAL**  
2 **SECURITY ACCOUNT STATEMENTS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1143 of the Social Secu-  
4 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1320b-13) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by adding at the end  
6 the following: “Such statement shall be provided by  
7 mail unless the requesting individual chooses elec-  
8 tronic delivery for that request.”; and

9 (2) in subsection (c)(2)—

10 (A) by striking “Beginning not later than”

11 and inserting “(A) Beginning not later than”;

12 (B) by inserting “by mail” after “provide”;

13 and

14 (C) by adding at the end the following:

15 “(B) In any case in which an eligible individual de-  
16 scribed in subparagraph (A) responds to an annual inquiry  
17 by the Commissioner relating to the mailing of the individ-  
18 ual’s statement by making an election that such statement  
19 for such year be provided in electronic form only, the re-  
20 quirements of this paragraph shall be deemed to be satis-  
21 fied for such year with respect to the individual.”.

22 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
23 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to social security  
24 account statements required to be provided after the date  
25 of the enactment of this Act.
