

Community Funding Projects Rep. Larson secured for the First District include:

- **\$4.35 million for the Town of East Hartford to:**
 - expand the East Hartford Library Complex, including new adult education and internet connectivity programs
 - improve safety and walkability on the Hockanum River Linear Park Trail
 - fund a multimodal infrastructure assessment along Main Street
 - to modernize Main Street's streetlights. These federal dollars will purchase energy efficient streetlights, making downtown safer for pedestrians.
- **\$1.6 million for the City of Hartford** to strengthen the storm water drainage system along Main Street in the North End
- **\$1.6 million to the Barkhamsted Housing Trust** to fund the construction of the Mallory View Affordable Housing project, improving access to housing in Litchfield County
- **\$1 million for the iQuilt Partnership** to assist with the construction of the RiverLink pedestrian bridge, connecting North Hartford residents with the Connecticut River
- **\$1 million for the Winsted Health Center Foundation** to convert the former Winsted Memorial Hospital into supportive housing for veterans
- **\$850,000 for the Phillips Business Complex** on North Main Street in Hartford to make needed infrastructure improvements
- **\$850,000 for the Town of Manchester** to create a more pedestrian, transit, and bike-friendly downtown around Main Street

- **\$850,000 for Goodwin University** to rehabilitate residential housing units, make safety improvements, and increase the economic viability of the area near the East Hartford campus
- **\$500,000 for Mercy Housing and Shelter** to rehabilitate and make capital improvements at four of their Hartford sites
- **\$500,000 for Mothers United Against Violence** to support their Victim Impact for Justice Project, working with the Hartford Police Department to support victims
- **\$500,000 for the Connecticut Housing and Development Corporation** to construct new mixed-income and affordable rental units at the Village at Park River in Hartford's Blue Hills neighborhood
- **\$250,000 for La Bodeguita de la Gente** to support a pantry that will serve immigrant families in Hartford with food, clothing, baby needs, and educational services
