
Chair DeLauro and Ranking Member Granger:

I am requesting \$6,000,000 in funding for the Church Corners Rehabilitation in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of East Hartford at 740 Main Street, East Hartford, 06108.

Situated at the intersection of Connecticut Boulevard and Main Street, the Church Corner's Inn is often the first building people see when they enter Downtown East Hartford. These funds are being requested to rehabilitate this structure from its present state as a crime-infected rooming house into high-quality one-bedroom housing with a set-aside for low income and veteran clients. This project address two urgent needs for the Town: quality lower-cost rental housing and the revitalization of the Downtown area.
