I am requesting funding for the Repairs/Renovation at Nellie B. West House at Camp Alice Merritt project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Hartland located at 22 South Road, East Hartland, CT 06027. The funding would be used to purchase a Generac Propane Generator (30kw) and Transfer Switch and a 1000 Gallon Above Ground Tank with Piping/Trenching/Concrete Pad.
