## American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding

- The Town of Rocky Hill has received more than \$6.8 million in ARP funding:
  - o \$2 million in Local Aid
  - o \$3.9 million in County Aid
  - \$297,293 in Educational Aid
- The Town of Rocky Hill has used a portion of its ARP funds to establish the Rocky Hill Small Business Assistance Program. The Program will provide limited, one-time direct financial assistance to eligible Rocky Hill businesses and non-profits adversely impacted by the COVID pandemic. It is intended to help businesses, non-profits and the Rocky Hill business community become stronger and prosper.
