I am requesting \$3,000,000 in funding for the Broad Street Complete Streets Improvement Project in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Windsor at 275 Broad Street, Windsor, CT 06095.

As proposed in the Windsor Center Transit-Oriented Development Master Plan and Redevelopment Strategy Study, this project seeks to reduce the two lanes of travel through Windsor Center into one lane of travel while maintaining circulation and traffic capacities, otherwise known as a "Road Diet". The overall goal is to reshape Windsor Center to become more pedestrian friendly and to add vitality to the downtown.
