



## **Bristol – Federal Funding Snapshot**

**Total Funding:** Over \$115 million

### **American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding**

- The City of Bristol has received more than **\$46 million** in ARP funding for local priorities, including:
  - **\$600,000** for the Bristol Boys and Girls Club's Outdoor Expansion Project
  - **\$400,000** for the Bristol Family Health and Wellness Center (FHWC)
  - **\$275,000** for Bristol Child Development Center (day care)
  - **\$1.1 million** for Bristol Health's hospital operating room
  - **\$1.2 million** for Environmental Learning Centers of Connecticut, Inc's Accessible Nature Trail - H.C. Barnes Memorial
  - **\$1.5 million** for Bristol Adult Resource Center's expansion and Administration Relocation
  - **\$2.4 million** for the Bristol Chamber of Commerce's Bristol In Demand: Workforce Dev. Training Program
  - **\$3.7 million** for City Hall upgrades
  - **\$5.2 million** for the Centre Square Public Parking Structure
  - **\$2 million** for the Building Bristol Grant program
  - **\$7.6 million** for Centre Square Public Parking Structure

## **Federal Grants:**

- **\$2.4 million** in Restaurant Revitalization Fund grants for **15** Bristol restaurants
- **\$1.5 million** Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF) grant to Bristol Public Schools to purchase laptops and internet equipment for students
- **\$125,000** to the City of Bristol for Drug-Free Communities Support
- **\$375,000** Assistance to Firefighters Grant for the Bristol Fire Department to purchase protective clothing and advanced communication technology
- **\$1,581,627** Public Housing Repair Fund award for the Housing Authority of the City of Bristol to rehabilitate and improve public housing units
- **\$8,172,845** from the Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV) to the Bristol Housing Authority to increase access to affordable housing.

## **Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)**

- **\$3.3 million** to improve traffic operations with better traffic signal timing and pedestrian crossings in the downtown area in anticipation of Depot Square development
- **\$17.8 million** – Rt 72 at Rt 69 Bristol Int Imp.
- **\$27,183** for CT 72 Realignment in Bristol
- **\$5.3 million** to replace Br #04487
- **\$3.6 million** to rehab Br #04488
