

Cromwell – Federal Funding Snapshot

Total Funding: Over \$6.4 million

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding:

- The Town of Cromwell has received more than \$5.4 million in **ARP** funding for local priorities, including:
 - o \$900,000 for renovating the tennis courts at Watrous Park
 - o \$500,000 for two new town dump/plow trucks
 - o \$200,000 for renovations at Henderson Lighting Fields
 - o \$165,000 for premium pay for Town and Fire District employees who worked through the height of the pandemic
 - o \$108,000 for a new police station roof
 - o **\$160,000** for a diesel mower
 - o \$212,000 for police vehicles
 - o \$150,000 for a pavilion at Watrous Park
 - o **\$450,000** for a PW Radio System
 - o \$300,000 for paving and roadway improvements
 - o \$50,000 for new flooring at the Senior Center

Federal Grants:

- \$33,000 Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF) grant to Cromwell Public Schools to purchase laptops and internet equipment for students
- \$1 million in Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grants for 5 Cromwell restaurants:

Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act

• \$6.3 million from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law is supporting roadway repairs and improvements in Cromwell
