



## **Cromwell – Federal Funding Snapshot**

**Total Funding:** Over \$6.4 million

### **American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding:**

- The Town of Cromwell has received more than **\$5.4 million** in **ARP** funding for local priorities, including:
  - **\$900,000** for renovating the tennis courts at Watrous Park
  - **\$500,000** for two new town dump/plow trucks
  - **\$200,000** for renovations at Henderson Lighting Fields
  - **\$165,000** for premium pay for Town and Fire District employees who worked through the height of the pandemic
  - **\$108,000** for a new police station roof
  - **\$160,000** for a diesel mower
  - **\$212,000** for police vehicles
  - **\$150,000** for a pavilion at Watrous Park
  - **\$450,000** for a PW Radio System
  - **\$300,000** for paving and roadway improvements
  - **\$50,000** for new flooring at the Senior Center

### **Federal Grants:**

- **\$33,000** Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF) grant to Cromwell Public Schools to purchase laptops and internet equipment for students
- **\$1 million** in Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grants for 5 Cromwell restaurants:

### **Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act**

- **\$6.3 million** from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law is supporting roadway repairs and improvements in Cromwell
