

# East Hartford – Federal Funding Snapshot

Total Funding: Over \$384 million

### American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding

- The Town of East Hartford has received more than **\$45.4 million** in **ARP** funding for local priorities, including:
  - **\$3.5 million** for the Wickham Library renovation
  - **\$5.7 million** to help local businesses recover from the pandemic
  - **\$480,000** for town facilities technology upgrades to improve residents services
  - **\$180,000** to expand staff to increase service levels at the senior center
  - **\$7.3 million** for repairs and renovations to historic town properties
  - **\$6.1 million** to replace the HVAC system in the town hall
  - **\$1.5 million** for non-HVAC town hall improvements
  - \$800,000 for youth employment programming
  - **\$1.4 million** for construction of public safety impound garage
  - \$900,000 for Main St/King CT stormwater drainage improvements
  - \$200,000 for digital inclusion to subsidize Internet Service Provider fees for low-income residents
  - **\$100,000** to assist victims of domestic violence
  - **\$720,000** for the senior center meal plan program

- \$350,000 for the Church Corners rehabilitation project
- \$484,000 for premium pay for Teamsters, CSEA,
  Firefighters, Police, AFSCME, and other town employees
- **\$200,000** for support for arts organizations and the display of art in public places
- **\$800,000** for employment services for underserved communities

- East Hartford Fire Department;
  - \$533,000 Assistance to Firefighters Grant from FEMA to purchase protective clothing and advanced communication technology.
- <u>Connecticut DOT</u>
  - \$2 million in funding through the Reconnecting Communities Pilot Program for the Greater Hartford Mobility Study
- <u>CT Department of Energy and Environmental Protection</u>
  - \$14.6 million grant through the Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Grant Program, a portion of which will be used to construct and install two new electric vehicle charging ports at Silver Lane Plaza.
- East Hartford Housing Authority
  - \$1,785,564 Public Housing Repair Fund award for rehabilitation and improvement projects to public housing units
  - **\$3,738,398** from the Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV) to increase access to affordable housing.
