Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Renovation of East Windsor Police Department and Warehouse Point School project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of East Windsor located at 11 Rye Street, East Windsor, CT 06016. Funding would be used to renovate and modernize the East Windsor Police Department while restoring the attached historic Warehouse Point School, allowing both parts of the facility to better serve the community.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it enhances public safety infrastructure for twenty-first century policing in a community that has the potential to grow in population by twenty percent in the next 3-5 years. The project would modernize the police station, and would renovate a historic school, currently abandoned, and return it to public use as programming and community space.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
