Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Parker Terrace Wastewater Pumping Station Upgrade project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Glastonbury located at 2149 Main Street, Glastonbury, CT 06033. Funding would be used to upgrade the Parker Terrace Wastewater Pumping Station.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it strengthens the Sewer Infrastructure for the Town of Glastonbury. The largest wastewater pump station in town will receive a full upgrade, including a new building, pumps, valves, and all electrical and controls components. This will ensure that that average flow of 1.1 million gallons of wastewater per day will make it to the Water Pollution Control Facility for treatment. This project is critical to Glastonbury's public health and economic development and will benefit both residential and commercial customers in town.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
