



Glastonbury – Federal Funding Snapshot

Total Funding: Over \$33.9 million

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding:

- The Town of Glastonbury has received more than **\$11.6 million** in **ARP** funding for local priorities, including:
 - **\$5.63 million** for capital improvements: fire apparatus, park maintenance, street light replacements, a new Animal Control Shelter
 - **\$63,500** on an EV vehicle/park maintenance/handicapped access
 - **\$115,000** for a small business assistance program

Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)

- **\$8 million** for projects on the State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP)
- **\$12.8 million** to rehab BR 00384/6 & Rt. 2 EB Mod
- **\$841,952** to replace the roof at the Glastonbury maintenance facility

Federal Grants

- **\$767,102** Public Housing Repair Fund award to the Housing Authority of the Town of Glastonbury for rehabilitation of public housing units

- **\$342,479** from the Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV) to the Glastonbury Housing Authority to increase access to affordable housing.
- **\$150,000** Assistance to Firefighters' Grant for the Glastonbury Fire Department to improve fire station air-quality for our first responders
- **\$2.4 million** in COVID relief funding to keep 11 local bars and restaurants open through the pandemic, such as Square Peg Pizzeria and Whole Deli
