RESOLUTION

Of inquiry requesting the President of the United States to furnish certain information to the House of Representatives relating to the Department of Government Efficiency's access to and usage of NUMIDENT and other personally identifiable information in the possession of the Social Security Administration.

- 2 requested to furnish the House of Representatives, not
- 3 later than 14 days after the date of adoption of this reso-
- 4 lution, copies of any document, record, audio recording,

1 memorandum, call log, correspondence (electronic or oth-
2 erwise), audit trails and audit logs, written agreements,
3 or other communication in his possession, or any portion
4 of any document, record, audio recording, memorandum,
5 call log, correspondence (electronic or otherwise), or other
6 communication, that refers or relates to the following:

1 Security Administration to the Department of
2 Homeland Security and copied to Steve Davis.

3 (3) Use of Cloudflare or any other third-party
4 server by DOGE members, including those working
5 at or with the Social Security Administration, to
6 share electronic files containing information in the
7 possession of the Social Security Administration.

8 (4) Actions by the DOGE, Elon Musk, any
9 member of his team, or any individual coordinating
10 with the DOGE to access, use, or transmit
11 NUMIDENT information or other personally identi-
12 fiable information in the possession of the Social Se-
13 curity Administration in violation of any laws, out-
14 side of Social Security Administration policy, or in
15 noncompliance with the temporary restraining order
16 issued by the District Court of Maryland on March
17 20, 2025 and the preliminary injunction granted by
18 the Court on April 17, 2025.
