



## **Middletown – Federal Funding Snapshot**

**Total Funding:** Over \$140 million

### **American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding**

- The City of Middletown has received more than **\$29 million** in **ARP** funding for local priorities, including:
  - **\$2.75 million** for immediate water and sewer needs
  - **\$1.2 million** for the Cross Street Training and Academic Center
  - **\$1 million** for the Middletown Fire Department
  - **\$1 million** for St. Vincent de Paul Middletown, LLC
  - **\$300,000** for the Downtown Business District
  - **\$100,000** for MARC Community Resources
  - **\$2.1 million** for NHCPA Riverbend, LLC
  - **\$250,000** for Middlesex Health
  - **\$300,000** for Gilead Community Services, Inc.
  - **\$200,000** for Community Health Center – Peer to Peer Program
  - **\$2.5 million** for DFC of Middletown
  - **\$96,000** for Middletown United Fathers' Inc. -- Racial Justice Coalition partnership

## Federal Grants

- **\$3.8 million** in Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grants for 24 Middletown restaurants
- Community Health Center Inc;
  - **\$500,000** through the Accelerating Cancer Screening grant
  - **\$15.1 million** through the Health Center Cluster grant to address racial disparities in healthcare outcomes
  - **\$432,000** through the Healthy Communities grant for the recruitment, training, and development of a new generation of public health leaders
  - **\$550,000** through the Technical Assistance to Community and Migrant Health Centers grant program to increase the capacity of healthcare providers that serve refugees and migrants
  - **\$1.1 million** through the Healthy Kids 2022 grant program to promote improved maternal and infant health outcomes for expectant parents
  - **\$135,000** through the Bridge Access Program to provide COVID 19 vaccines to the uninsured
- Wesleyan University;
  - **\$475,000** through Allergy, Immunology, and Transplantation Research funding
  - **\$49,000** through a Fulbright-Hays Doctoral Dissertation Research funding
  - **\$471,000** through Pharmacology, Physiology, and Biological Chemistry Research funding
- Moses-Weitzman Health System;
  - **\$300,000** through Rural Communities Opioid Response Program funding to conduct outreach and treatment for opiate misuse
  - **\$424,628** Networks for Oral Health Integration within the Maternal and Child Health Safety grant program award to improve access to oral care

- The Connecticut Association for Community Actions;
  - **\$1.2 million** through Diaper Distribution Demonstration and Research Pilot program
- Westfield Fire Department
  - **\$8,036** Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG)
- Middletown Housing Authority:
  - **\$1,016,119** Public Housing Repair Fund award to improve and rehabilitate public housing units
  - **\$8,967,004** from the Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV) to increase access to affordable housing.

#### **Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA):**

- **\$78.8 million** for Rt 17 Ramp to Rt 9 North Improvement
- **\$2.4 million** to Upgrade Portland St RR Xing
- **\$2.3 million** to Repl. Bridge (Culvert) #06891
- **\$7.1 million** for D1 and D2 Traffic Control Signals
