



Portland – Federal Funding Snapshot

Total Funding: Over \$39.6 million

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding

- The Town of Portland has received more than **\$6.8 million** in ARP funding for local priorities, including:
 - **\$1.1 million** for Water & Sewer Projects
 - **\$184,000** for Police Body Cams
 - **\$120,000** for Land Use Office (digitizing records, updating town GIS mapping, instituting a user-friendly online permitting process)
 - **\$965,000** for Fire Engine #2 Replacement
 - **\$120,000** for 12 Passenger Senior Center Bus
 - **\$32,000** for a Generator for Firehouse #3
 - **\$977,000** for the Portland Board of Education (upgrades to the track, auditorium sound systems, Chromebooks for students, school underground oil tank removal)

Federal Grants

- **\$250,000** Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF) grant to purchase laptops and internet equipment for students
- **\$3.3 million** in Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grants to 4 Portland restaurants

- **\$173,952** Public Housing Repair Fund award to the Portland Housing Authority for public housing unit improvements and restoration projects
- **\$721,565** from the Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV) to the Portland Housing Authority to increase access to affordable housing.

Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA):

- **\$5.6 million** for Curve Signs/Pavement Markings
- **\$4.4 million** for Traffic Signal Safety Improvements Project #1
- **\$5.5 million** for D2 Traffic Control Signals
- **\$4.7 million** for D2 Traffic Signal Revisions
- **\$9 million** for D2 Traffic Control Signals
