



Rocky Hill – Federal Funding Snapshot

Total Funding: Over \$125 million

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding

- The Town of Rocky Hill has received more than **\$5.9 million** in **ARP** funding for local priorities, including;
 - Over **\$50,000** for library upgrades
 - Over **\$50,000** for stipends to first responders
 - Over **\$345,000** for HVAC upgrades for Fire and Police Departments
 - Over **\$1.5 million** for police support, police overtime pay, and to pay the salaries of two police officers
 - Over **\$650,000** to salary senior programs and senior activities directors

Federal Grants:

- **\$3.6 million** in Restaurant Revitalization Fund grants for **17** Rocky Hill restaurants
- **\$1.8 million** to Nutmeg State Credit Union for the CDFI Rapid Response Program to provide COVID relief support to underserved organizations
- **\$56,125** Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF) grant to the Town of Rocky Hill to purchase laptops and internet equipment for students
- **\$2 million** Small Cities Community Development Block Grant for renovations to the 36 Willow Road Housing Development

Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA):

- **\$109 million** to Construct CT DOT D1 Facilities
- **\$2,828** for New Bridge Safety Facility
- **\$275,000** for New Sign, Signal and Radio Labs
- **\$2.8 million** for Wrong Way Signs with Flashers
