Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,


I am requesting funding for the Chapel Road Pump Station Renovation project for fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Town of South Windsor, located at 1540 Sullivan Avenue, South Windsor, CT 06074. The funding would be used to rehabilitate and improve the town's Chapel Road Pump Station, enabling the municipality to continue commercial development in the immediate area surrounding the pump station.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this project will increase the pump station's treatment capacity, reduce its operational costs, and unlock commercial development opportunities along the Buckland Road corridor in town. The Chapel Road Pump Station is quickly approaching its designed capacity, and as the town completes a groundwater infiltration evaluation of its sewage system, funding from this project will enable the town to swiftly and effectively remediate its growing treatment capacity problems.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
