

## South Windsor – Federal Funding Snapshot

**Total Funding:** Over \$11.4 million

## American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding:

- The Town of South Windsor has received more than \$9 million in ARP funding for local priorities, including:
  - o \$1 million for UV disinfection Upgrades
  - o \$1 million for Phase IV Sewer and Manhole Rehabilitation
  - o \$100,000 for Human Services Benefit Assistance
  - o \$300,000 for Mental Health Supports for Youth, Adults, and Senior Citizens
  - o \$120,000 for a Youth Behavior Counselor
  - o \$80,000 for a aquatics water safety program
  - \$900,000 for Dart Hill Road & Ellington Road/Long Hill Road Sidewalks
  - \$250,000 for BOE Fiber Build New Pleasant Valley and Orchard Hill School
  - \$800,000 for Fiber Build to SW Sewer Treatment Plant and BOE Administration Building
  - o \$500,000 for town hall renovations
  - o \$500,000 for HVAC upgrades to fire houses
  - o \$100,000 for exercise trails at Nevers Park
  - o \$28,000 for Teen Center outdoor space

## **Federal Grants:**

- \$2 million in Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grants for 10 South Windsor restaurants
- \$420,150 from the Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV) to the Housing Authority of the Town of South Windsor to increase access to affordable housing.

## Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA):

• \$470,000 for Pedestrian safety improvements at Eli Terry Elementary School
