



Southington – Federal Funding Snapshot

Total Funding: Over \$34 million

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding

- The Town of Southington has received more than **\$17 million** in **ARP** funding for local priorities, including:
 - **\$600,000** for highway and park sweepers
 - **\$1.6 million** for park improvements
 - **\$1.5 million** for town pool and structures
 - **\$1.8 million** for Patten Brook and Old Judd Brook pump stations
 - **\$300,000** for a dump truck
 - **\$120,000** final payment for new ladder truck

Federal Grants:

- Restaurant Revitalization Fund:
 - **\$9.7 million** for **25** Southington restaurants and venues, including **\$5 million** for the Aqua Turf
- Emergency Connectivity Fund (to purchase laptops and equipment for students to gain internet access at home):
 - **\$834,700** to Southington Public Schools
- Southington Fire Department
 - **\$1.2 million** SAFER grant to fully staff a third fire station in Milldale. Rep. Larson visited in October to announce this grant.
- Southington Public Schools

- **\$10,000** American Rescue Plan: Humanities Grants for Libraries grant to develop new genealogy programming and digitize their archives, so they are accessible to the public 24/7.
- General Pulaski Terrace
 - **\$2,000,000** for the modernizing of the residential buildings. Ten residential buildings with a total of 40 units and a community building.

Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)

- **\$3.3 million** to replace bridge BR #04560 in Southington
