



Torrington – Federal Funding Snapshot

Total Funding: Over \$27.7 million

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding:

- The City of Torrington has received more than **\$16 million** in **ARP** funding for local priorities, including:
 - **\$569,281** for English as a 2nd language, teachers, paras & tutors to address English learning students. Social worker to address re-engagement and emotional support
 - **\$286,937** for the City's Façade and Building Improvement Grant Program
 - **\$36,000** for a temporary medical clinic at Coe Park Civic Center
 - **\$1 million** for construction of the Animal Control Facility
 - **\$10,074,000** for pandemic resources, sustaining and strengthening economic recovery, maintaining vital services and make investments that support long-term growth, opportunity, and equity
 - **\$1.75 million** for community impact grants

Federal Grants:

- Bad Dog Brewing Company;
 - **\$92,000** Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grant
- Community Health And Wellness Center Of Greater Torrington, Incorporated;
 - **\$18,700** Bridge Access Program funding for COVID-19 vaccine access and administration to the underinsured
 - **\$1,073,177** Health Center Program funding to close healthcare outcome gaps between racial groups
- Torrington Housing Authority
 - **\$757,646** Public Housing Repair Fund award to rehabilitate and improve public housing units

Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA):

- **\$10 million** for 2022 D4 Pavement Press

Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Awards:

- **\$1.3 million** – Torrington Riverfront
