

Wethersfield-Federal Funding Snapshot

Total Funding: Over \$56 million (since 2021)

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding

- The Town of Wethersfield has received more than \$10.3 million in ARP funding for local priorities, including:
 - o \$315,000 for roof replacement at the Hillcrest School
 - o \$444,000 for a new HVAC system at the Community Center
 - o \$618,000 for new SCBA for the fire department
 - o \$200,000 for a new HVAC system for the police station
 - o \$400,000 for a new roof for the town garage
 - o \$440,000 for resurfacing basketball and tennis courts
 - o \$404,000 for parks upgrades
 - o \$600,000 for Old Wethersfield parking upgrades

Federal Grants:

- \$155,000 Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF) grant to purchase laptops and internet equipment for students
- \$3.3 million through three Department of Transportation grants to the State Department of Motor Vehicles
- \$150,000 Technology Initiative grant to Statewide Legal Services of Connecticut
- \$10 million State Apprenticeship State Apprenticeship Expansion, Equity and Innovation grant to the CT Department of Labor

- \$3.3 million in Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grants for 12 Wethersfield restaurants
- \$2 million Small Cities Community Development Block Grant for Renovations at Harvey Fuller Senior Housing
- Governors Partnership to Protect Connecticut's Workforce
 - \$90,360 award from AmeriCorps VISTA, funding to hire and train staff to assist in a statewide initiative to address the opioid crisis.
- \$545,678 from the Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV) to the Housing Authority of the Town of Wethersfield to increase access to affordable housing.

• \$27 million to rehab Br #00811 in Wethersfield
