Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,


I am requesting funding for the Memorial Hall Elevator Access project for fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Windsor Locks, located at 50 Church Street, Windsor Locks, CT 06096. The funding would be used to support the design, purchase, and installation of an elevator for Memorial Hall in the Town, providing safe and convenient access to the upper floors of the building for all veterans and all community members.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this project will grant equal access to all areas of the historic facility, which serves as a meeting place for the American Legion. The upper floors of the building are currently only accessible by stairwells, and funding from this project will ensure that elderly or disabled veteran members of the community can safely and easily access all areas of the facility which are used for meetings and public purposes.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
