



Winsted – Federal Funding Snapshot

Total Funding: Over \$15.9 million

American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Funding:

- The Town of Winsted has received more than **\$4.7 million** in ARP funding for local priorities, including:
 - **\$40,000** for Town Marketing & Economic Development Activities
 - **\$50,000** for a Director of Economic Development
 - **\$100,000** for Business Start-Up
 - **\$10,000** for Water Quality Improvement Program
 - **\$200,000** for 800-band Radios
 - **\$67,366** for Ambulance Components
 - **\$75,000** for Firehouse Improvements
 - **\$350,000** for Sewer Plant Raw Water Pumps
 - **\$350,000** Sewer Pump Station Rehabilitation
 - **\$20,210** for Senior Center "No Senior Left Behind" Technology Program
 - **\$60,000** for a Social Services Social Services Coordinator

Community Project Funding FY24:

- **\$1 million** for the Winsted Health Center Foundation's Winsted Veterans Center project

Federal Grants:

- **\$1 million** to Northwestern Connecticut Community College
 - **\$750,000** for Preparing STEM Scholars for Transfer and the Workforce
 - **\$223,000** for rural health care initiatives
- **\$219,000** Shuttered Venues Operator Grant (SVOG) to the Gilson Cafe and Cinema
- **\$62,000** Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF) grant to Winchester Public Schools to purchase laptops and internet equipment for students
- **\$32,000** Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) for the Winsted Fire Department
- **\$911,000** in Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) grants for 7 Winsted restaurants
- **\$263,032** Public Housing Repair Fund award to the Winchester Housing Authority for rehabilitation and improvements to public housing units

Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act:

- **\$3.7 million** for the rehabilitation of Bridge #05127 which carries Case Avenue over Mad River in Winchester
- **\$4.1 million** for the replacement of Bridge No. 01571 carrying Route 263 over East Branch Naugatuck River in Winchester
